

Tar roads projects underway in Aganang

“ALTHOUGH Aganang Municipality will be disestablished and be incorporated into Polokwane Municipality, Molemole and Blouburg in a few months to come, that cannot stop us from delivering good services to our people as we promised.” These words were spoken by Aganang Mayor, Maria Mokobodi, during the tar roads project sod turning ceremony in Moletjie on Friday. She also shed light on future projects. “A total of R23 million will be spent on tarring 1,9 km road from Lonsdale via Flora to Percy clinic in Moletjie, 1,5 km road from Mohlonong to Kalkspruit and upgrading of Mohlonong Stadium in Ga-Mashashane.”

Mokobodi said the municipality was proud of the services they delivered during the last five years. Envisioned in the years to come, is also the upgrading of Mohlonong Stadium. Moletjie Traditional Authority, Senior Traditional Councillor, Solomon Moloto, said they were grateful for the projects in the villages. “We hope these projects will help us a lot. Having tarring roads throughout our municipality was always our wish. We are happy today that the municipality has met our needs, because the long gravel roads was always a challenge to us,” said Moloto.

Lehlogonolo Shoroma is one of the contractors under the projects. “With a good relationship between the municipality and the residents as a whole, towards the agreement of the three months everything will be done to the final stage and in a professional way,” Shoroma confirmed.
