



The descriptor as revised by the Heraldry Department.

The symbolism of the coat of arms as follows:

- 1. The descriptions are as follows: The Marula tree symbolises protection, nourishment and growth.**
- 2. The three mounts in the centre of the shield and the one in the base of the shield allude to the natural heritage of the Municipality and the sense of achievement.**
- 3. The Sun refers to prosperity and the dawning of a bright future.**
- 4. The maize cob symbolises subsistence farming and the core economic activity.**
- 5. The hoes allude to the hard working people of the area.**
- 6. The Crown alludes to excellence.**
- 7. The linked chain on the crown symbolises the co-operation between the various tribal authorities to create unity and to strengthen the bonds of fraternity for the people.**
- 8. The yellow colour symbolises a unified history, strength and a bright future.**
- 9. The white colour reflects peace and tranquility.**
- 10. The Blue sky reflects the sunrise and hope.**
- 11. The motto MMOGO RE TLA KGONA means co-operation, unity and achievement.**
